FOOD ASSISTANCE IN LAWRENCE COUNTY

SNAP—Food Stamp Program

- SNAP (the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program—formerly Food Stamps) SNAP is the cornerstone of all federal nutrition assistance programs, providing benefits for the purchase of nutritious food to qualified low-income people in addition to economic benefits for the local community.
- Participants receive monthly benefits via an electronic debit card, known as the Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) card, that can be used to buy food at any store that accepts food stamps.
- **Do I qualify?** Eligibility is based on income and resources available to the household. You may receive SNAP benefits even if you do not receive cash assistance. SNAP benefits are not welfare.

Cash Assistance (TANF)

- Cash Assistance or TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) provides a monthly cash allotment to eligible families.
- Participants receive a monthly allotment of money on an EBT card.

Summer Feeding Program

Women, Infants & Children

- WIC provides nutritious foods and services for eligible women who are pregnant, breastfeeding, or recently had a baby; infants; and children under 5. Go to www.pawic.com for income guidelines or call 1-800-WIC-WINS. WIC is an equal opportunity provider.
- Fruits, veggies, whole grains, jarred infant foods, and dairy alternatives (soy milk, tofu and cheese) are now offered in addition to milk, eggs, peanut butter, cereal, juice, infant formula, and beans. Additional vouchers for fresh produce in summer and fall are also available.

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) provides a free nutritious box of food to qualified senior citizens 60 and older and those families who have been referred to the program by WIC.
