## **Portable Oxygen Policy**

Passengers may travel with respirators and properly secured portable oxygen supplies <sup>1</sup>.

- Passengers traveling with <u>portable oxygen concentrators</u> are **not** required to secure the concentrator in any particular place in the vehicle.
- Passengers traveling with <u>portable compressed oxygen cylinders</u> must have the cylinder properly secured in the upright position.
- ACTS recommends traveling with double the amount of oxygen that you believe you may need for your initial trip, appointment, and return trip.
- Passengers using portable oxygen supplies are not required to sit in any particular seat on the vehicle unless they also utilize a mobility device, which must be secured in the vehicle's designated securement area. Oxygen supplies must not obstruct the aisleway of the bus <sup>2</sup>.
